

A parable (pronounced PAIR-uh-bul) is a short, fictitious story that illustrates a moral or religious principle. Rabbis in Jesus' day would use parables to hold an audience's attention while explaining important points of teaching.

Parables were a hallmark of Jesus' ministry. In fact, a full 35% of his words in scripture take the form of parables. Jesus said they were designed to both reveal and conceal his message about the arrival of God's kingdom on earth.

This reading plan will give you an opportunity to read through all of Jesus' parables found in the Gospel of Matthew. Some will be yield their meaning immediately. Others may cause you to scratch your head because they require knowledge of 1st-century Palestinian farming practices. If you're left perplexed by one, don't hesitate to reach out to Rev.
