

It's tempting to imagine that the earliest Christians lived and worshipped together in perfect harmony, loving one another just as Jesus had instructed them to do. The truth, however, is much more complicated. From the very beginning of the church, there have been controversies over the best and most appropriate way to live out Jesus' command to love.

In the process, it gives us a glimpse into many of the controversies that popped up along the way. This 4-week reading plan will lead you through the book's entirety.
