

# Sermon *on the* Mount

## BIBLE READING PLAN

The Sermon on the Mount is a collection of sayings and teachings attributed to Jesus in the Gospel of Matthew. It is the longest continuous discourse of Jesus found in the New Testament and includes some of its best-known teachings (e.g. the Beatitudes, the Lord's Prayer).

The Sermon takes place relatively early in Jesus' ministry, just after he has been baptized by John the Baptist, finished his fasting and spiritual retreat in the desert, and begun to preach in Galilee. While the name and location of the mountain is unstated, the Mount of Beatitudes, a hill on the shore of Lake Galilee, is the traditional interpretation.

This four-week bible reading plan will guide you through the entirety of the Sermon on the Mount, first as discrete teachings and then as a united discourse.
