They challenge us to seek wisdom, to be open to the Holy Spirit's guidance, and to engage in the ongoing, transformative process of discerning God's will. It's not about finding easy answers, but about developing a posture of attentiveness to the Divine, a willingness to engage deeply with the complexities of faith and life.
