Too often, the Bible has been used to exclude, shame, or erase LGBTQ+ people. But when read with fresh eyes and an open heart, scripture tells a very different story. It tells the story of a God who delights in diversity, honors our bodies, and invites all people into beloved community. Pride Month is the perfect time to reclaim that story, not just as a message of affirmation, but as a declaration of deep spiritual truth.

This four-week Bible reading plan accompanies our Wonderfully Made sermon series, guiding you through six days of scripture each week with Sundays reserved for rest and reflection. Each week follows a theme: creation, embodiment, belonging, and empowerment. The goal is not just to offer comfort. It is to spark transformation, challenge injustice, and help you see yourself and others through the eyes of a relentlessly loving God.

Whether you have walked with the Bible your whole life or have only known it as a source of pain, you are invited to engage these passages with fresh ears. Let them speak anew. Let them reveal a God who knit you together with intention and joy. And let them remind you that being wonderfully made is not a gualifier for God's love. It is the starting point.
